MISSION STATEMENT / LOCAL FOCUS:

Children Succeeding in School, Parents are involved in all aspects of their children's lives

OPERATING STRUCTURE:

Collaborative Council with 38 member agencies and programs.

LOCAL FCFC CORE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **Community Capacity Building/Planning:** strategies and outcomes
PFS Sustainability County. Centralized planning body for the county social services delivery.
- **Service Coordination:** strategies and outcomes
Centralized service coordination process facilitated by Council Coordinator. Three tiered management of plans and funding of family service plans through Council committees utilizing ABC, FAST and Non-Behavioral Health funds. Have increased school participation in referring children to Service Coordination from 5% to 40%. School districts participate in 95% of all service coordination plans.
- **Family Empowerment:** strategies and outcomes
Maintain three family representatives on council who are actively involved in committee work. Utilize administrative funds to support stipends and travel expenses for family representatives
- **Early Childhood System of Care:** strategies and outcomes
Council's standing ECCC committee actively involved in Council. Council conducts annual parent and provider survey of Help Me Grow Services. Works in collaboration with Education Service Center to establish comprehensive transition planning services.

LOCAL CHILDREN'S TRUST FUND RESPONSIBILITIES (As Applicable):

- **Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention:** strategies and outcomes
Support community based parenting groups utilizing STEP Curriculum. Provide respite opportunities to children at risk of abuse and neglect. Outcomes: Increase appropriate adult supervision and monitoring, increase families valuing education

Total FCFC Budget : \$900,000. Administrative budget: \$85,000.

Full Time Council Coordinator, Half-time administrative assistant
